

WASECA COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION—JUNE 16, 2008

The Waseca County Board of Equalization met on Monday, June 16, 2008 at 9:00 A. M. in the Commissioner's Room, 300 N State St. Waseca, Minnesota.

Hans Holland, District Court Administrator, administered the oath of office.

The Board then organized as follows: Dan Kuhns, Chairperson; Jim Peterson, Vice-Chairperson; and Joan Manthe, Clerk.

The Board of Equalization members present were Dan Kuhns, Al Ruhland, Jim Peterson, Rick Morris and Joan Manthe. Also present were Mark Vagts and Jim Pemble, Appraisers from Waseca County Assessor's Office.

Mark Vagts explained that this meeting is to discuss the market value for 2008, payable 2009 taxes only. The owner needs to have attended the Board of Review before he can speak to the Board of Equalization.

Mark Vagts handed out copies of farm land sales in the county as well as information on ag assessments and a list of top taxpayers in the county.

George Kastle, landowner in St. Mary township, briefly spoke to the board about high taxes. He did not attend the Board of Review.

No other persons were present. No correspondence was received.
